We hope this message finds you and your family well. The following contains important information for students taking a 2020 summer school course at Walnut High School.

Summer school textbook pickup for all summer school courses and programs at WHS will utilize drive through pick up as our school campus remains closed. Based on guidance from the school district and health department we will continue to use the same format that was developed for WHS textbook drop off.

Your course has been assigned a window on a given day. Please refer to the schedule below and identify your **pick up time based on the course you are taking**. Please make arrangements to drive on to campus based on the schedule below. Due to the many restrictions we remain under - please make every effort to pick up your textbook at that time. There will be a very limited number of make up time slots for emergency situations on Monday June 8 in the afternoon. However, we want to ensure that you have your required textbook when school begins Monday morning.

Please identify your pick up window and then refer to the map attached to this message for additional information on how to proceed through the WHS Student Parking Lot.

Summer school rosters have been finalized and the district is in the process of making this information available to teachers. Summer school teachers will be sending out Google invites to students to join their class at the end of next week. Please continue to check you WVUSD Student Gmail account for this invite. Also, beginning Monday, periodically check the website information associated with your summer course. www.dedicated2learning.org or www.walnuths.net for updates. Summer school staff will be available to assist you as summer school opens in the event any student is having difficult connecting with their teacher. Our students should be familiar with the Google Classroom platform at this time as we will continue to use the same Google Classroom, Google Meet, and Google Chat functions that they have been practicing over the past 2 months.
