

2025 Dedicated to Learning Summer School **Tentative Course Offerings at the WHS Campus**

Dedicated to Learning is pleased to offer the following courses for the coming 2025 Summer Session. All classes are held on the Walnut High School Campus. Online classes, while based at Walnut High School, are conducted exclusively (including exams) in a virtual learning environment utilizing the Google Classroom course management platform.

Online courses: In keeping with WVUSD online course expectations, online courses will have daily tasks assigned and there will be a synchronous check in with students each week to offer additional instruction and support for our students. Assignment upload / submission deadlines will be assigned by the teacher. Our online courses continue to be designed for the student who prefers an alternative environment from which to complete their schoolwork. These classes are also designed for students who will be out of the area during summer, working from home, or attending the various campus, internships, or athletic events many of our students engage in during the summer. Currently the only online course with daily (synchronous) attendance required is online World History Honors.

D2L courses are not filled as “first come first served.” Any application submitted by the registration window deadline will be considered to allow families to choose which course is best for their student. Our courses are available to both students within the WVUSD as well as from surrounding school districts, however only WVUSD students are allowed to register during the first registration window.

Students can take a maximum of 1 “In-Seat” Course (10 Credits) AND 1 Online Semester course (5 Credits). This is a total of 15 allowable credits during the summer session.

Students are responsible for meeting course pre-requisites when completing the application process in order for enrollment to be valid. Students submitting *invalid* applications will be dropped from the course, **without a refund**. Course offerings may change prior to registration and courses may also be cancelled due to lack of enrollment. Please keep in mind that science and math courses are demanding and compress a full school year of material into a 6 week summer session. They require a substantial study time commitment outside of the school day. Students taking science or math courses for the first time (original credit) *should consider themselves to be strong in these areas.*

At the time of registration you will have the opportunity to select your 1st choice course and a 2nd choice. If there is a second class you would like to take if your first choice is not available, or if we are unable to place you, please enter it at the time of registration. Please only select a 2nd choice if you intend to take that course if awarded a spot.

***A \$20 science lab fee is included in the Tuition for Biology and Chemistry classes. All courses are in-seat unless noted as “Online” in the course description.**

Math Courses	Pre-Requisites	Credits	Tuition
GEOMETRY	Grades 9-12 - “B” grade or better in Alg. 1 is required. CSU/UC A-G Approved. Current 8th grade students and 9 th Grade students are advised to check with the WHS IB Coordinator and GLC if there are questions about their specific pathway. The IB recommendation is to take either World History Honors or Biology Honors. However, students who wish to accelerate in math may take this summer Geometry course prior to enrolling in Algebra 2 or Algebra 2 H during the coming school year.	10	\$800
ALGEBRA 2 Honors	Grades 9-12 “B” or better in Geometry and Algebra 1. CSU/UC A-G Approved. This is an intensive Honors level course.	10	\$800
ALGEBRA 2	Grades 9-12. Students need to have earned a C or better in Geometry and a grade of B or better in Algebra 1 is strongly recommended.	10	\$800

BIOLOGY HONORS*	<u>Students considering the WHS IB Program often take Biology Honors or World History Honors prior to starting 9th grade to help balance their schedules and workload for the coming year.</u> This course is open to all grades and is appropriate for students seeking an Honors level lab science. CHEMISTRY HONORS*	Grades 10-12 “B” or better in Geometry and Biology Honors <u>or</u> “B” or better in Geometry and an “A” in	10	\$820*

CSU/UC A-G Approved.</p> <p>This course has the same goals as regular Chemistry, including laboratory exercises, but the content area is more extensive and rigorous covering some of the standards not assessed by the CST. Inorganic matter is studied in depth and scope. Chemistry problems introduced require extensive use of mathematics and are on an advanced conceptual level. This course emphasizes key CA Content Standards in Chemistry and prepares students for AP Chemistry.</p>

U.S. HISTORY Online	<p>Class of 2025 and 2026 only. CSU/UC A-G Approved. This course is designed for the online learning environment. Lessons are packaged and paced by an online learning specialist to guide the students through this curriculum. Daily assignments are completed following the teacher's syllabus along with the teacher offering synchronous instruction one time per week to support students.</p>	10	\$800
U.S. HISTORY HONORS	<p>Classor 2025 and 2026. CSU/UC A-G Approved. D2L U.S. History Honors is a weighted course that will help you continue to demonstrate a high degree of rigor on your college applications. <i>Design based learning</i> and activities will be emphasized whenever possible to create an active non-traditional learning environment that goes beyond traditional lecture, read, and test classroom.</p>	10	\$800

WORLD HISTORY - Online	<p>Grades 9 & 10. UC / CSU A-G Approved. This course is designed for the online learning environment. Lessons are packaged and paced by an online learning specialist to guide the students through this curriculum. The work is completed on an independent basis with assignment due dates set by the teacher. The course teacher will also offer a weekly synchronous lesson and discussion to support our students.</p>	10	\$800
PSYCHOLOGY - Online	<p>Introduction to Psychology. Meets the Elective requirement for graduation; satisfies CSU/UC category "G" entrance requirements. This class can also be taken to help students ready themselves for Psychology AP coursework. This course is designed for the online learning environment. Lessons are packaged and paced by an online learning specialist to guide the students through this curriculum. The work is completed on an independent basis with assignment due dates set by the teacher. The course teacher will also offer a weekly synchronous lesson and discussion to support our students.</p>	10	\$800
Civics Online – 6 Week	<p>Civics is available only to incoming 12th Grade students. This course is designed for the online learning environment. 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**Visual Performing Arts/
Applied Arts / Elective
Courses**

Pre-Requisites

Kinesiology (P.E.) Online	Open to all students. Meets State and District Physical Education requirements for graduation. Students taking this course must complete the coursework within the 6 week summer session. Our course utilizes the approved Physical Education Independent Study curriculum from the WVUSD. Students will complete a combination of activity logs and online worksheets. Students taking online PE will choose to complete either 5 credits (1 semester of PE) or the Full Year option below.	5	\$500
Kinesiology (Combo - Online learning plus physical activity logs)	Open to all grade levels. Students will take five credits online through learning modules. The other five credits will be satisfied through physical fitness activities done independently and documented by a parent or guardian. This course meets State and District Physical Education requirements for graduation. This class runs 6 weeks. All coursework and exams are online. At the completion of this course, students will have satisfied 1 year of their PE requirement for High School.	10	\$800
Photography - Online	This course provides students with an “online” option for completing their Visual Performing Arts (VPA) requirement. Discover the art of photography through photo composition, portrait lighting, and explore various photo techniques—all with the use of a cell phone camera! No need for a professional digital camera nor Photoshop. You will use easy-to-access, web-based applications to enhance and elevate your images. This class is appropriate for all grade levels 9-12. Health Online	Grades 9 - 12. Open enrollment. Meets the "State Required Course (SRC)" requirement for graduation. This class runs 6 weeks. All coursework and exams are online. This course is designed for the online learning environment. Lessons are packaged and paced by an online learning specialist to guide the students through this curriculum. The work is completed on an independent basis with assignment due dates set by the teacher. The course teacher will also offer a weekly synchronous lesson and discussion to support our students.	5	\$500
Health - On site at WHS	Grades 9 - 12. Open enrollment. Meets the "State Required Course (SRC)" requirement for graduation. This class runs <u>3 weeks</u> . It is a course completed on the WHS campus during Weeks 1-3.	5	\$500
