## SUMMER SCHOOL SESSION, 2019

Sponsored by *Dedicated to Learning at CHAPARRAL MIDDLE SCHOOL*

Dedicated to Learning, a nonprofit corporation, has been authorized by the Walnut Valley Unified School District to provide a Summer School program at Chaparral Middle School. Dedicated to Learning, in an effort to provide the best possible learning environment for your children, will predominantly employ Walnut Valley Unified administrators, teachers and staff for its summer session of enrichment classes.

The courses offered through the Dedicated to Learning will be financed through tuition. Any students currently attending a school in the Walnut Valley Unified School District, or who reside in the Walnut District attendance area and will be **in grades 6, 7, or 8 in August of 2019** may enroll in courses appropriate for them, as class size permits.

**There will be one, six-week session offered to students at Chaparral Middle School this summer:** Monday, June 10 – Thursday, July 18, 2019.

Classes will meet as listed below:

**ENROLLMENT OPTIONS:** There are two options for enrollment.

- Partial day enrollment classes run from 7:30 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. each day, with two periods of classes offered to students each day.
- Full day enrollment runs from 7:30 A.M. to 2:45 P.M. each day, with three periods of classes offered to students each day.

**FOOD SERVICES:** Snacks will be made available for purchase during the break, and during lunch. However, there will be no “meals” available for purchase. Students staying for all three periods should bring their own sack lunch from home.

**CLASS SIZE:** Each course offered through this program will have a class size of approximately 25-35 students, excluding PE.

**TUITION\*:** There are three “periods” available to students. Each period costs \$300 (for a total of \$600 half day, \$900 full day).

\* Some classes may require an additional lab fee.

Enrollment begins March 11, 2019 until classes fill. **Students are to choose ONE CLASS per period; if a class is full, please add your name to the waiting list or choose another.**

**Students may not be placed in the same class for multiple periods.**

- ✓ All payments are online. **There will be NO REFUNDS.**

**\*Registration requests will be processed in the order they are received on a “first come, first served” basis. SPACE IS LIMITED.**
